## FOR STUDENTS APPLYING IN THE 2026–2027 ERAS CYCLE

Interview season is an organizational problem. Dozens of programs, each with its own deadlines, signal decisions, and interview logistics, usually managed in a homemade spreadsheet until an invite gets buried, two interviews land on the same day, or a signal goes to the wrong program.

CycleDoc puts all of it in one place:

-  **Spreadsheet import** — paste your existing list from Excel or Google Sheets and your cycle builds itself, **no retyping**
-  **Program tracker** — every program, deadline, and application status in **one view**
-  **Signal planner** — track allocations by tier and **catch over-planning** before you submit
-  **Interview manager** — invites, scheduled dates, and **same-day conflict alerts**
-  **Rank list notes** — capture impressions after each interview **while they're fresh**
-  **Cost log** — application fees and travel expenses in **one running total**
